God's love

No.	Chapter and verse	Content
1	Numbers 14:18	'I, the Lord, am not easily angered, and I show great love and faithfulness and forgive sin and rebellion. Yet I will not fail to punish children and grandchildren to the third and fourth generation for the sins of their parents.'
2	Deuteronomy 7:13	He will love you and bless you, so that you will increase in number and have many children; he will bless your fields, so that you will have grain, wine, and olive oil; and he will bless you by giving you many cattle and sheep. He will give you all these blessings in the land that he promised your ancestors he would give to you.
3	1 Kings 8:23	and prayed, "Lord God of Israel, there is no god like you in heaven above or on earth below! You keep your covenant with your people and show them your love when they live in wholehearted obedience to you.
4	Nehemiah 1:5	"Lord God of Heaven! You are great, and we stand in fear of you. You faithfully keep your covenant with those who love you and do what you command.
5	Psalms 5:7	But because of your great love I can come into your house; I can worship in your holy Temple and bow down to you in reverence.
6	Matthew 23:37	"Jerusalem, Jerusalem! You kill the prophets and stone the messengers God has sent you! How many times I wanted to put my arms around all your people, just as a hen gathers her chicks under her wings, but you would not let me!
7	John 14:21	"Those who accept my commandments and obey them are the ones who love me. My Father will love those who love me; I too will love them and reveal myself to them."
8	Romans 8:38-39	For I am certain that nothing can separate us from his love: neither death nor life, neither angels nor other heavenly rulers or powers, neither the present nor the future, neither the world above nor the world below—there is nothing in all

		creation that will ever be able to separate us from the love of God which is ours through Christ Jesus our Lord.
9	2 Corinthians 9:8	And God is able to give you more than you need, so that you will always have all you need for yourselves and more than enough for every good cause.
10	Galatians 2:20	so that it is no longer I who live, but it is Christ who lives in me. This life that I live now, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave his life for me.
11	Ephesians 1:4-5	Even before the world was made, God had already chosen us to be his through our union with Christ, so that we would be holy and without fault before him. Because of his love God had already decided that through Jesus Christ he would make us his children—this was his pleasure and purpose.
12	Philippians 2:1	Your life in Christ makes you strong, and his love comforts you. You have fellowship with the Spirit, and you have kindness and compassion for one another.
13	Colossians 3:12	You are the people of God; he loved you and chose you for his own. So then, you must clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience.
14	2 Thessalonians 2:16	May our Lord Jesus Christ himself and God our Father, who loved us and in his grace gave us unfailing courage and a firm hope,
15	1 John 4:8-9	Whoever does not love does not know God, for God is love. And God showed his love for us by sending his only Son into the world, so that we might have life through him.
16	Revelation 3:19	I rebuke and punish all whom I love. Be in earnest, then, and turn from your sins.
17	Proverbs 3:12	The Lord corrects those he loves, as parents correct a child of whom they are proud.
18	Isaiah 44:2	I am the Lord who created you; from the time you were born, I have helped you. Do not be afraid; you are my servant, my chosen people whom I love.
19	Lamentations 3:22-23	The Lord's unfailing love and mercy still continue, Fresh as the morning, as sure as the sunrise.

20	Hosea 11:4	I drew them to me with affection and love. I picked them up and held them to my cheek; I bent down to them and fed them.
21	Micah 7:18	There is no other god like you, O Lord; you forgive the sins of your people who have survived. You do not stay angry forever, but you take pleasure in showing us your constant love.
22	Zephaniah 3:17	The Lord your God is with you; his power gives you victory. The Lord will take delight in you, and in his love he will give you new life.

God's favor/God's grace

No.	Chapter and verse	Content
23	2 Samuel 7:29	I ask you to bless my descendants so that they will continue to enjoy your favor. You, Sovereign Lord, have promised this, and your blessing will rest on my descendants forever.
24	Isaiah 49:8	The Lord says to his people, “When the time comes to save you, I will show you favor and answer your cries for help. I will guard and protect you and through you make a covenant with all peoples. I will let you settle once again in your land that is now laid waste.
25	Lamentations 3:58-60	“You came to my rescue, Lord, and saved my life. Judge in my favor; you know the wrongs done against me. You know how my enemies hate me and how they plot against me.
26	John 1:17	God gave the Law through Moses, but grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.
27	Acts 20:32	“And now I commend you to the care of God and to the message of his grace, which is able to build you up and give you the blessings God has for all his people.
28	Romans 12:6	So we are to use our different gifts in accordance with the grace that God has given us. If our gift is to speak God's message, we should do it according to the faith that we have;

29	2 Corinthians 12:9	But his answer was: “My grace is all you need, for my power is greatest when you are weak.” I am most happy, then, to be proud of my weaknesses, in order to feel the protection of Christ’s power over me.
30	Titus 2:12	That grace instructs us to give up ungodly living and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright, and godly lives in this world,
31	2 Timothy 1:9	He saved us and called us to be his own people, not because of what we have done, but because of his own purpose and grace. He gave us this grace by means of Christ Jesus before the beginning of time,

God’s compassion (pity)

No.	Chapter and verse	Content
32	Exodus 33:19	The Lord answered, “I will make all my splendor pass before you and in your presence I will pronounce my sacred name. I am the Lord, and I show compassion and pity on those I choose.
33	Psalms 119:156	But your compassion, Lord, is great; show your mercy and save me!
34	Isaiah 30:19	You people who live in Jerusalem will not weep any more. The Lord is compassionate, and when you cry to him for help, he will answer you.
35	Zechariah 10:6	I will make the people of Judah strong; I will rescue the people of Israel. I will have compassion on them and bring them all back home. They will be as though I had never rejected them. I am the Lord their God; I will answer their prayers.
36	James 5:11	We call them happy because they endured. You have heard of Job’s patience, and you know how the Lord provided for him in the end. For the Lord is full of mercy and compassion.
37	Hebrews 4:16	Let us have confidence, then, and approach God’s throne, where there is grace. There we will receive mercy and find grace to help us just when we need it.
38	Isaiah 49:13	Sing, heavens! Shout for joy, earth! Let the mountains burst into song! The Lord will comfort his people; he will have pity on his suffering people.

God's deliverance (salvation, rescue)

No.	Chapter and verse	Content
39	Deuteronomy 4:37	Because he loved your ancestors, he chose you, and by his great power he himself brought you out of Egypt.
40	2 Corinthians 5:14	We are ruled by the love of Christ, now that we recognize that one man died for everyone, which means that they all share in his death.
41	Ephesians 5:2	Your life must be controlled by love, just as Christ loved us and gave his life for us as a sweet-smelling offering and sacrifice that pleases God.
42	Titus 3:4-5	But when the kindness and love of God our Savior was revealed, he saved us. It was not because of any good deeds that we ourselves had done, but because of his own mercy that he saved us, through the Holy Spirit, who gives us new birth and new life by washing us.
43	1 John 3:16	This is how we know what love is: Christ gave his life for us. We too, then, ought to give our lives for others!
44	Ephesians 2:8-9	For it is by God's grace that you have been saved through faith. It is not the result of your own efforts, but God's gift, so that no one can boast about it.
45	Psalm 27:1	The Lord is my light and my salvation; I will fear no one. The Lord protects me from all danger; I will never be afraid.
46	Psalm 32:7	You are my hiding place; you will save me from trouble. I sing aloud of your salvation, because you protect me.

God's righteousness

No.	Chapter and Verse	Content
47	Romans 3:25-26	God offered him, so that by his blood he should become the means by which people's sins are forgiven through their faith in him. God did this in order to demonstrate that he is righteous. In the past he was patient and overlooked people's sins; but in the present time he deals with their sins, in order to demonstrate his righteousness. In this way God shows that he himself is righteous and that he puts right everyone who believes in Jesus.
48	Romans 5:21	So then, just as sin ruled by means of death, so also God's grace rules by means of righteousness, leading us to eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.
49	2 Corinthians 5:21	Christ was without sin, but for our sake God made him share our sin in order that in union with him we might share the righteousness of God.
50	Philippians 3:9	and be completely united with him. I no longer have a righteousness of my own, the kind that is gained by obeying the Law. I now have the righteousness that is given through faith in Christ, the righteousness that comes from God and is based on faith.
