No.	Chapter and verse	Content
1	Numbers 14:18	'I, the Lord, am not easily angered, and I show great love and faithfulness and forgive sin and rebellion. Yet I will not fail to punish children and grandchildren to the third and fourth generation for the sins of their parents.'
2	Deuteronomy 7:8	But the Lord loved you and wanted to keep the promise that he made to your ancestors. That is why he saved you by his great might and set you free from slavery to the king of Egypt.
3	Deuteronomy 7:9	Remember that the Lord your God is the only God and that he is faithful. He will keep his covenant and show his constant love to a thousand generations of those who love him and obey his commands,
4	Deuteronomy 7:13	He will love you and bless you, so that you will increase in number and have many children; he will bless your fields, so that you will have grain, wine, and olive oil; and he will bless you by giving you many cattle and sheep. He will give you all these blessings in the land that he promised your ancestors he would give to you.
5	1 Kings 8:23	and prayed, "Lord God of Israel, there is no god like you in heaven above or on earth below! You keep your covenant with your people and show them your love when they live in wholehearted obedience to you.
6	1 Chronicles 16:34	Give thanks to the Lord, because he is good; his love is eternal.
7	Nehemiah 1:5	"Lord God of Heaven! You are great, and we stand in fear of you. You faithfully keep your covenant with those who love you and do what you command.
8	Job 10:12	You have given me life and constant love, and your care has kept me alive.

9	Psalm 5:7	But because of your great love I can come into your house; I can worship in your holy Temple and bow down to you in reverence.
10	Psalm 5:12	You bless those who obey you, Lord; your love protects them like a shield.
11	Psalm 11:7	The Lord is righteous and loves good deeds; those who do them will live in his presence.
12	Psalm 23:6	I know that your goodness and love will be with me all my life; and your house will be my home as long as I live.
13	Psalm 25:7	Forgive the sins and errors of my youth. In your constant love and goodness, remember me, Lord!
14	Psalm 31:7	I will be glad and rejoice because of your constant love. You see my suffering; you know my trouble.
15	Psalm 32:10	The wicked will have to suffer, but those who trust in the Lord are protected by his constant love.
16	Matthew 23:37	“Jerusalem, Jerusalem! You kill the prophets and stone the messengers God has sent you! How many times I wanted to put my arms around all your people, just as a hen gathers her chicks under her wings, but you would not let me!
17	John 3:16	For God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not die but have eternal life.
18	John 13:1c	He had always loved those in the world who were his own, and he loved them to the very end.
19	John 14:21	“Those who accept my commandments and obey them are the ones who love me. My Father will love those who love me; I too will love them and reveal myself to them.”
20	John 14:23	Jesus answered him, “Those who love me will obey my teaching. My Father will love them, and my Father and I will come to them and live with them.

21	John 15:13-14	The greatest love you can have for your friends is to give your life for them. And you are my friends if you do what I command you.
22	John 16:27	for the Father himself loves you. He loves you because you love me and have believed that I came from God.
23	John 17:23	I in them and you in me, so that they may be completely one, in order that the world may know that you sent me and that you love them as you love me.
24	Romans 5:5	This hope does not disappoint us, for God has poured out his love into our hearts by means of the Holy Spirit, who is God's gift to us.
25	Romans 5:8	But God has shown us how much he loves us—it was while we were still sinners that Christ died for us!
26	Romans 8:28	We know that in all things God works for good with those who love him, those whom he has called according to his purpose.
27	Romans 8:35	Who, then, can separate us from the love of Christ? Can trouble do it, or hardship or persecution or hunger or poverty or danger or death?
28	Romans 8:37	No, in all these things we have complete victory through him who loved us!
29	Romans 8:38-39	For I am certain that nothing can separate us from his love: neither death nor life, neither angels nor other heavenly rulers or powers, neither the present nor the future, neither the world above nor the world below—there is nothing in all creation that will ever be able to separate us from the love of God which is ours through Christ Jesus our Lord.
30	2 Corinthians 9:8	And God is able to give you more than you need, so that you will always have all you need for yourselves and more than enough for every good cause.
31	Galatians 2:20	so that it is no longer I who live, but it is Christ who lives in me. This life that I live now, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave his life for me.
32	Ephesians 1:4-5	Even before the world was made, God had already chosen us to be his through our union with Christ, so that we would be holy and without fault before him. Because of his love God had already decided that through Jesus Christ he would make us his children—this was his pleasure and purpose.

33	Ephesians 3:18	so that you, together with all God's people, may have the power to understand how broad and long, how high and deep, is Christ's love.
34	Philippians 2:1	Your life in Christ makes you strong, and his love comforts you. You have fellowship with the Spirit, and you have kindness and compassion for one another.
35	Colossians 3:12	You are the people of God; he loved you and chose you for his own. So then, you must clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience.
36	2 Thessalonians 2:13	We must thank God at all times for you, friends, you whom the Lord loves. For God chose you as the first to be saved by the Spirit's power to make you his holy people and by your faith in the truth.
37	2 Thessalonians 2:16	May our Lord Jesus Christ himself and God our Father, who loved us and in his grace gave us unfailing courage and a firm hope,
38	1 John 3:1	See how much the Father has loved us! His love is so great that we are called God's children—and so, in fact, we are. This is why the world does not know us: it has not known God.
39	1 John 4:8-9	Whoever does not love does not know God, for God is love. And God showed his love for us by sending his only Son into the world, so that we might have life through him.
40	1 John 4:16	And we ourselves know and believe the love which God has for us. God is love, and those who live in love live in union with God and God lives in union with them.
41	Revelation 3:19	I rebuke and punish all whom I love. Be in earnest, then, and turn from your sins.
42	Psalms 37:28	for the Lord loves what is right and does not abandon his faithful people. He protects them forever, but the descendants of the wicked will be driven out.
43	Psalms 40:11	Lord, I know you will never stop being merciful to me. Your love and loyalty will always keep me safe.
44	Proverbs 3:12	The Lord corrects those he loves, as parents correct a child of whom they are proud.

45	Isaiah 44:2	I am the Lord who created you; from the time you were born, I have helped you. Do not be afraid; you are my servant, my chosen people whom I love.
46	Isaiah 54:10	The mountains and hills may crumble, but my love for you will never end; I will keep forever my promise of peace.” So says the Lord who loves you.
47	Lamentations 3:22-23	The Lord's unfailing love and mercy still continue, Fresh as the morning, as sure as the sunrise.
48	Hosea 11:4	I drew them to me with affection and love. I picked them up and held them to my cheek; I bent down to them and fed them.
49	Micah 7:18	There is no other god like you, O Lord; you forgive the sins of your people who have survived. You do not stay angry forever, but you take pleasure in showing us your constant love.
50	Zephaniah 3:17	The Lord your God is with you; his power gives you victory. The Lord will take delight in you, and in his love he will give you new life.
51	Malachi 1:2a	The Lord says to his people, “I have always loved you.”

God's favor/God's grace

No.	Chapter and verse	Content
52	2 Samuel 7:29	I ask you to bless my descendants so that they will continue to enjoy your favor. You, Sovereign Lord, have promised this, and your blessing will rest on my descendants forever.
53	Isaiah 49:8	The Lord says to his people, “When the time comes to save you, I will show you favor and answer your cries for help. I will guard and protect you and through you make a covenant with all peoples. I will let you settle once again in your land that is now laid waste.

54	Isaiah 58:8-9	“Then my favor will shine on you like the morning sun, and your wounds will be quickly healed. I will always be with you to save you; my presence will protect you on every side. When you pray, I will answer you. When you call to me, I will respond.
55	Lamentations 3:58-60	“You came to my rescue, Lord, and saved my life. Judge in my favor; you know the wrongs done against me. You know how my enemies hate me and how they plot against me.
56	John 1:17	God gave the Law through Moses, but grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.
57	Acts 20:32	“And now I commend you to the care of God and to the message of his grace, which is able to build you up and give you the blessings God has for all his people.
58	Romans 3:24	But by the free gift of God’s grace all are put right with him through Christ Jesus, who sets them free.
59	Romans 5:2	He has brought us by faith into this experience of God’s grace, in which we now live. And so we boast of the hope we have of sharing God’s glory!
60	Romans 5:15	But the two are not the same, because God’s free gift is not like Adam’s sin. It is true that many people died because of the sin of that one man. But God’s grace is much greater, and so is his free gift to so many people through the grace of the one man, Jesus Christ.
61	Romans 11:6	His choice is based on his grace, not on what they have done. For if God’s choice were based on what people do, then his grace would not be real grace.
62	Romans 12:6	So we are to use our different gifts in accordance with the grace that God has given us. If our gift is to speak God’s message, we should do it according to the faith that we have;
63	1 Corinthians 15:10	But by God’s grace I am what I am, and the grace that he gave me was not without effect. On the contrary, I have worked harder than any of the other apostles, although it was not really my own doing, but God’s grace working with me.
64	2 Corinthians 4:15	All this is for your sake; and as God’s grace reaches more and more people, they will offer to the glory of God more prayers of thanksgiving.

65	2 Corinthians 6:2	Hear what God says: “When the time came for me to show you favor, I heard you; when the day arrived for me to save you, I helped you.”
66	2 Corinthians 8:9	You know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ; rich as he was, he made himself poor for your sake, in order to make you rich by means of his poverty.
67	2 Corinthians 12:9	But his answer was: “My grace is all you need, for my power is greatest when you are weak.” I am most happy, then, to be proud of my weaknesses, in order to feel the protection of Christ’s power over me.
68	Galatians 1:15	But God in his grace chose me even before I was born, and called me to serve him.
69	Ephesians 1:7	For by the blood of Christ we are set free, that is, our sins are forgiven. How great is the grace of God,
70	Ephesians 2:4-5	But God’s mercy is so abundant, and his love for us is so great, that while we were spiritually dead in our disobedience he brought us to life with Christ. It is by God’s grace that you have been saved.
71	Ephesians 2:7	He did this to demonstrate for all time to come the extraordinary greatness of his grace in the love he showed us in Christ Jesus.
72	2 Timothy 1:9	He saved us and called us to be his own people, not because of what we have done, but because of his own purpose and grace. He gave us this grace by means of Christ Jesus before the beginning of time,
73	Titus 2:12	That grace instructs us to give up ungodly living and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright, and godly lives in this world,
74	James 4:6	But the grace that God gives is even stronger. As the scripture says, “God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble.”
75	1 Peter 5:10	But after you have suffered for a little while, the God of all grace, who calls you to share his eternal glory in union with Christ, will himself perfect you and give you firmness, strength, and a sure foundation.
76	2 Peter 3:18	But continue to grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To him be the glory, now and forever! Amen.

God's compassion (pity)

No.	Chapter and verse	Content
77	Exodus 33:19	The Lord answered, "I will make all my splendor pass before you and in your presence I will pronounce my sacred name. I am the Lord, and I show compassion and pity on those I choose.
78	Exodus 34:6	The Lord then passed in front of him and called out, "I, the Lord, am a God who is full of compassion and pity, who is not easily angered and who shows great love and faithfulness.
79	Psalm 119:156	But your compassion, Lord, is great; show your mercy and save me!
80	Isaiah 30:19	You people who live in Jerusalem will not weep any more. The Lord is compassionate, and when you cry to him for help, he will answer you.
81	Zechariah 10:6	I will make the people of Judah strong; I will rescue the people of Israel. I will have compassion on them and bring them all back home. They will be as though I had never rejected them. I am the Lord their God; I will answer their prayers.
82	James 5:11	We call them happy because they endured. You have heard of Job's patience, and you know how the Lord provided for him in the end. For the Lord is full of mercy and compassion.
83	Hebrews 4:16	Let us have confidence, then, and approach God's throne, where there is grace. There we will receive mercy and find grace to help us just when we need it.
84	Isaiah 49:13	Sing, heavens! Shout for joy, earth! Let the mountains burst into song! The Lord will comfort his people; he will have pity on his suffering people.

God's deliverance (salvation, rescue)

No.	Chapter and verse	Content
85	Deuteronomy 4:37	Because he loved your ancestors, he chose you, and by his great power he himself brought you out of Egypt.
86	2 Corinthians 5:14	We are ruled by the love of Christ, now that we recognize that one man died for everyone, which means that they all share in his death.
87	Ephesians 5:2	Your life must be controlled by love, just as Christ loved us and gave his life for us as a sweet-smelling offering and sacrifice that pleases God.
88	Titus 3:4-5	But when the kindness and love of God our Savior was revealed, he saved us. It was not because of any good deeds that we ourselves had done, but because of his own mercy that he saved us, through the Holy Spirit, who gives us new birth and new life by washing us.
89	1 John 3:16	This is how we know what love is: Christ gave his life for us. We too, then, ought to give our lives for others!
90	1 John 4:10	This is what love is: it is not that we have loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son to be the means by which our sins are forgiven.
91	Ephesians 2:8-9	For it is by God's grace that you have been saved through faith. It is not the result of your own efforts, but God's gift, so that no one can boast about it.
92	Titus 2:11	For God has revealed his grace for the salvation of all people.
93	Psalms 27:1	The Lord is my light and my salvation; I will fear no one. The Lord protects me from all danger; I will never be afraid.
94	Psalms 32:7	You are my hiding place; you will save me from trouble. I sing aloud of your salvation, because you protect me.
95	Psalms 62:7	My salvation and honor depend on God; he is my strong protector; he is my shelter.

96	Jonah 2:9	But I will sing praises to you; I will offer you a sacrifice and do what I have promised. Salvation comes from the Lord!”

God’s righteousness

No.	Chapter and Verse	Content
97	Romans 3:25-26	God offered him, so that by his blood he should become the means by which people’s sins are forgiven through their faith in him. God did this in order to demonstrate that he is righteous. In the past he was patient and overlooked people’s sins; but in the present time he deals with their sins, in order to demonstrate his righteousness. In this way God shows that he himself is righteous and that he puts right everyone who believes in Jesus.
98	Romans 5:21	So then, just as sin ruled by means of death, so also God’s grace rules by means of righteousness, leading us to eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.
99	2 Corinthians 5:21	Christ was without sin, but for our sake God made him share our sin in order that in union with him we might share the righteousness of God.
100	Philippians 3:9	and be completely united with him. I no longer have a righteousness of my own, the kind that is gained by obeying the Law. I now have the righteousness that is given through faith in Christ, the righteousness that comes from God and is based on faith. Ephesians
